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- Criteria are established to classify the FARMCs according to five levels of development.
- Each level has corresponding indicators that will guide the FARMC in achieving full functionality.
- These indicators will also serve as basis for necessary interventions to build the capacity of the FARMCs as partners of the government in the management of municipal waters.

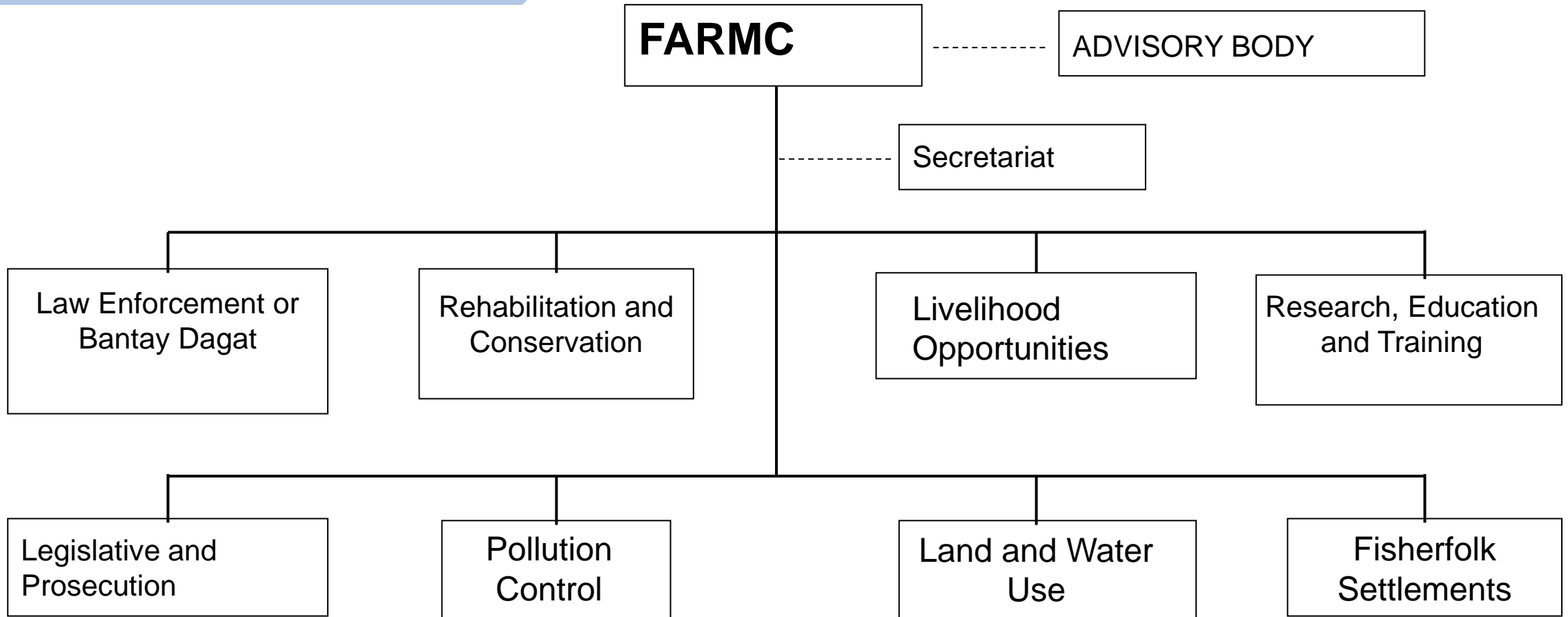

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FARMC STRUCTURE



A FARMC has a secretariat and several committees that focus on specific concerns. Other committees may be added as the need arises.

Level 1 ensures that the FARMC has been organized properly. This means that the members know their roles and their functions. This prepares the FARMC in taking on its various responsibilities as a partner in fisheries management.

Level 2 guides the FARMC to focus on its true mandate as specified in the 1998 Fisheries Code and to give priority to activities that would enhance the private sector-government partnership processes.

Level 3 assesses the FARMC's effectiveness in ensuring that their inputs to management have been successfully integrated to the local processes. At this point, the LGU and the FARMC is expected to have developed a good partnership for managing the municipal waters

Level 4 guides the FARMC & the LGU on the mechanisms to sustain the partnership. It also specifies indicators that would help both the FARMC & the LGU in making sure that the gains of the partnership efforts are sustained.
